

RULES & CONDITIONS

1. Combined Training classes will be run under Pony Club rules for Dressage with Show Jumping Competitions 2017. The pure dressage classes will be run under Pony Club Dressage rules 2017.
2. **Entries to reach the secretary by Friday 26th May 2017. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**
3. Dressage times will be posted on the East Kent Hunt Pony Club website from the Monday 29th May and by telephone on Monday 29th May between 7-9pm on 01227 709589. This telephone number should not be used at any other time.
4. Commanders are permitted in all classes.
5. Rosettes to 6th place in all classes.
6. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or any other way whatsoever.
7. In the event of cancellation 15% of the entry fee per competitor will be retained.
8. No stallions.
9. Any objections are to be made at the secretary's tent within 30 minutes of the alleged incident accompanied by a deposit of £10. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld; if the objection is dismissed the deposit will be retained.
10. Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not must where protection headgear which includes a permanently fixed non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two places and properly adjusted at all times.
11. Please take all litter home with you and please DO NOT muck out horseboxes on the showground. **12.** No dogs are allowed on the showground
