Conditions of Admittance

1. No liability is accepted by the Owners or occupiers of the premises or by the organisers of any event taking place upon the premises for any damage to the person or any damage to or loss of the property of any person being a competitor or spectator or otherwise whether ensuing as result of negligence or any cause whatsoever (save where deemed otherwise by law or statute).
2. All dogs must be kept on a lead
3. Except in specified "Riding Areas" horses may only be ridden or led at walk.
4. Anyone using abusive language or behaviour will be asked to leave the showground.
5. Horseboxes and trailers must not be mucked out on the showground. Please pick up litter and droppings as the land is used for grazing.

Competition Conditions of Entry

1. Competitors must wear correct dress including approved riding hats which comply with current BS safety standards, correctly fastened at all times when mounted.
2. The organisers reserve the right to refuse or eliminate any entry without stating a reason and refuse to repay any entry fee.
3. The Judge's decision is final (subject to objections heard in accordance with condition 6 below).
4. No horse or pony under 4 years old in any ridden class.
5. Judges and organisers are empowered to eliminate a competitor for excessive use of the whip or spurs or any other maltreatment of any animal inside or outside the ring.
6. Any objection to the running or result of any competition must be made to the secretary within twenty minutes of the incident accompanied by a £10 cash deposit which will be returned only in the event of the objection being sustained. Objections will be referred to a committee comprising the Judge and two other assessors nominated by the organisers and shall be heard as quickly as possible. Such committee may sustain or dismiss any objection, or alter the result of any competition as it deems fit. The determination of an objection in such manner shall be final and binding upon all competitors.
