

Rules of entry

- Riders/Handlers to wear smart clothes. Plaiting is optional
- Hats to current kite mark standard and adequate footwear must be worn at all times whilst mounted, body protectors are optional.
- Please leave parking area tidy and free from rubbish and droppings. No mucking out of boxes on the showground
- Any dogs must be kept on lead and under control at all times, all mess must be cleaned up and disposed of immediately.
- Judges word is final. Complaints to be made in writing to Squirrells Riding School accompanied with £10.
- Over use of the whip may incur faults or being marked down.
- Classes subject to change, see website for details.
- No horses under 4 years to be ridden
- Squirrells Riding School are not responsible for any loss, theft or damage that should occur whilst competing. You should be aware that riding is a high risk sport and you do so at your own risk. Squirrells are not responsible for any accidents on the show ground.
- Advanced entries close 5 days before the show, any entries received after this time will incur an extra charge and will only be permitted if space allows.
- No entries can be refunded unless a medical/veterinary certificate is produced or in exceptional cases at the discretion of the proprietor.

In hand classes Ring 1

Prompt 9.00am start

Class 1 - Child Handler

Class 2 - Best Coloured

Class 3 - Best veteran age 15 +

Class 4 - Prettiest pony/horse

Class 5 - Best Breed horse/pony

Championship for in hand will be held promptly at the end of the in hand classes.

Ridden classes Ring 1

Approx 11.30am start

Class R1 - A - Lead rein rider - age 12 and under

B - First ridden -any age includes senior C - Best rider class to include canter

Class R2 - Best Mare/Gelding (split if enough entries)

Class R3 - Best ridden breed horse /pony

Class R4 - Ridden ring experience

Class R5 - Family horse /pony

A horse that any member of the family can ride Class R6 - Best Heinz 57 (Novelty Class)

Championship for ridden classes will be held promptly at the end of the classes.

Jumping Classes

All classes jumped on a rubber surface

Clear round 8.00-11.00 - Ring 2

£4 or 3 rounds £10

Rosettes for all clear rounds

increasingly to 1'6". Once raised they cannot be lowered Starting with poles on the floor, the jumps will be raised

Show jumping classes

Class 2 – Minimis cross poles 40cm Class 3 starters straights -45cms Class 6 - Squirrells 80cm Class 4 – Squirrells 60cm Class 5 -Squirrells 70cm Class 7 - Squirrells 90m Class 8 – Accumulator Class 1 - Bottom hole

Classes 3-7 are open to all ages, qualification will be split into Classes 1 & 2 are JUNIOR only (ages 16 and under) All clears go through to a jump off. All jumping classes are £10 entry. Junior and Senior categories
